

- All who are able are encouraged to attend





 - Initially refused to allow a vitiligo patient to hang a flyer advertising her support group in their office
 - Social media pressure and phone calls from the vitiligo community forced the office to have a change of heart



- A patient came to see Dr. John Harris recently and was told by his insurance that the office visit was not covered because he was seen for vitiligo
- Tufts Commercial Health Plan in MA
- Dr. Harris has brought this to light and is working with other members of the vitiligo patient community to have this policy reversed
